Hayhurst's Scalopwing (1–1.25")	Rare: L-Jul to M-Aug	Woods edges along streams	Burdock	Lamb's quarters
Dreamy Duskywing (1.1–1.5")	Uncommon: E-May to E-Jun	Dry fields & woods trails	Mud puddles	Willows, poplars, aspens
Sleepy Duskywing (1.25–1.75")	Uncommon: M-Apr to E-May	Woods trails & edges	Mud puddles	Scrub oak
Swarthy Skipper (1–1.2")	Uncommon: Jun, Aug & Sep	Dry fields with broomsedge	Low grassblades	Little bluestem beardgrass
European Skipper (1–1.2")	Uncommon: M to L-Jun	Fields with tall grass	Purple vetch	Timothy grass
Northern Broken-Dash (1–1.25")	Uncommon: M-Jun to E-Aug	Weedy fields	Indian hemp, milkweed	Panic grasses
Mulberry Wing (1.1–1.5")	Uncommon: E to M-Jul	Interiors of sedge marshes	Swamp milkweed	Tussock sedge
Dusted Skipper (1.25–1.7")	Rare: L-May	Dry fields with beardgrass	Low grassblades	Little bluestem beardgrass
Ocola Skipper (1.3–1.7")	Rare: L-Aug, Sep	Wet meadows	New York ironweed	Grasses
Cloudless Sulphur (2.25–3.1")	Rare: L Aug - M Sep	Open fields	Senna, partridge pea	Sennas
Harvester (1.1–1.25")	Rare: Jun & Aug	Wet, bushy woods trails	Mud puddles near alders	Larvae feed on wooly aphids
Bronze Copper (1.25–1.9")	Rare: L May - & M-Aug	Marshes & wet meadows	Indian hemp (dogbane)	Water dock & curled dock
Coral Hairstreak (1–1.5")	Rare: L-Jun	Old fields, powerline cuts	Butterflyweed	Wild cherry, chokecherry
Striped Hairstreak (1–1.5")	Rare: L-Jun	Swamp & marsh edges	Indian hemp, N.J. tea	Blueberry, hawthorn
Eastern Pine Elfin (1–1.25")	Rare: L-Apr to E-Jun	Open scrub pine groves	Pussytoes	Various hard pines
